DAY 1 BOARD THE INDIAN PACIFIC IN SYDNEY

Departing Sydney's Central Station, settle into your first evening on the Indian Pacific. Enjoy the fabulous food, wine, service and social atmosphere of this much-loved rail journey.

DAY 2 INDIAN PACIFIC, BROKEN HILL AND ADELAIDE

After breakfast, prepare for your first Off Train Excursion in frontier town Broken Hill, followed by a day enjoying the outback scenery. Upon arrival in Adelaide, you'll have more Off Train Excursions to choose from before continuing your journey west. (B,L,D)

DAY 3 INDIAN PACIFIC, NULLARBOR PLAIN

Today is all about those amazing views as you cross this famous stretch of the Australian interior. Dinner this evening is under an outback sky on the edge of the country's largest sheep station at Rawlinna (seasonal). (B,L,D)

DAY 4 INDIAN PACIFIC, PERTH

Watch the delightful Avon Valley pass, whilst the final stage of this transcontinental crossing unfolds as you head into Perth just after lunch.

OVERNIGHT: 2 nights Pan Pacific Perth (B,L)

DAY 5 LEISURE DAY

It might be the largest State in Australia but its capital city is a wonderfully compact centre packed with things to see and do. Enjoy your day at leisure in Perth visiting Kings Park, Barrack Square or the many museums and galleries. (B)

WE RECOMMEND

Arcades and Laneways Walking tour \$50 per person.

The Arcades and Laneways guided walk reveals the city's hidden gems, evolving small bar scene, street art hotspots, and recent developments including The Bell Tower and Elizabeth Quay.

DAY 6 **PERTH TO BROOME**

This morning your adventure continues with a flight to beautiful Broome. Here you have the afternoon free to enjoy this uniquely multicultural resort town and its famous 22-kilometre long Cable Beach.

DAY 7 **BROOME**

Your guide reveals the colourful story behind the growth of Broome. Pearling has been influential in shaping modern Broome, and you'll get a 90-minute masterclass on this fascinating industry along with a Pearling Master's High Tea. Visit famous Cable Beach, the dinosaur tracks of Gantheaume Point, well-known Matso's Brewery, the Japanese Cemetery, and more.

DAY 8 **LEISURE DAY**

Your day is at leisure to enjoy more of Broome and its surrounds.

WE RECOMMEND

Cape Leveque Adventure \$269 per person.

Take a walk on the wild side of this north west pocket of Australia on a 4WD adventure to pristine Cape Leveque exploring Indigenous Bardi country. You'll visit Indigenous communities, swim in crystal clear seas on deserted beaches, tour a remote aquaculture hatchery and Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm, and more.

DAY 9 **LEISURE DAY**

Today is free for you to explore Broome – visit historic Chinatown overlooking Roebuck Bay, shop for pearls, or take a sunset camel ride along Cable Beach.
