### SYDNEY TO PERTH

DEPARTING WEDNESDAY (YEAR ROUND)

#### DAY 1 SYDNEY

#### DAY 2 BROKEN HILL, BAROSSA VALLEY AND ADELAIDE SURROUNDS

You arrive in the Silver City of Broken Hill as the day begins, where you embark on a morning of Off Train Experiences. Lunch is served on board as the Indian Pacific enters the southern tip of the spectacular and ancient Flinders Ranges. Arriving in the city of Adelaide in the afternoon, you have the choice of a tour of the city, a visit to the world famous Barossa Valley or McLaren Vale (seasonal) wine regions, or a trip to the beautiful Adelaide Hills featuring the culinary delights of Hahndorf.



#### DAY 3 NULLARBOR PLAIN

### PERTH TO SYDNEY DEPARTING SUNDAY (YEAR ROUND)

 4 DAYS  3 NIGHTS

#### DAY 1 PERTH AND KALGOORLIE

Your journey from the Indian Ocean to the Pacific Ocean begins as you pull away from the platform in Perth mid-morning. Enjoy a modern Australian lunch as you watch the scenery glide by. Indulge in a three-course dinner prior to your late evening arrival into the Kalgoorlie region.

#### DAY 2 NULLARBOR PLAIN

Awake to the spectacular expanse of the Nullarbor Plain to watch the sunrise. Waiting ahead is the charm of the once thriving Nullarbor railway community — now ghost town — of Cook. Another mouth-watering dinner is followed by relaxed conversation in the lounge before a restful night's sleep.

#### DAY 3 ADELAIDE AND BROKEN HILL

On arrival in Adelaide, you have the choice of a city walking tour (seasonal), a behind-the-scenes experience of the world famous Adelaide Oval, a guided walk through of the Adelaide Central Markets, or take a coach tour of the city sights. This evening you'll enjoy a quick stop at Broken Hill, Australia's silver capital.



#### DAY 4 BLUE MOUNTAINS AND SYDNEY

Wake in the picturesque Blue Mountains. See the majestic Three Sisters at Echo Point and the views at Jamison Valley before completing your journey on our chartered New South Wales rail service (fully hosted by our staff) into Sydney Central Station. Alternatively, stay on board the Indian Pacific to travel directly to Sydney.
